  - 3. Report After Operations Against the Enemy, 010001 April to 302400 April 1945:

lat April 1945, the Mg 5th TD Group mesigned to Seventh Army and attacked to XV Corps was located in GROS UMSTADT, Germany (MS 58414), Map of GERMANI. Mank destroyer battlions in XV Corps were disposed as follows: On Corps left (North) flank the 645th TD Mm supported the 45th Inf Div. On Corps right (South) flank, the 601st TD Mm supported the 3d Inf Div. In a reserve position behind the 45th Div, the 776th TD Mm was assembled with the 44th Inf Div. The 636th TD Mm was atobd to the 14th Armd Div in a reserve assembly area.

The Irad Section, Seventh Army, notified 5th TD Group that 12 radios of 300 series were being recommended per TD battalion to expedite communications, which emincided with recommendation of the Group Commender. S-2, 776th TD Bm, visited Group CP for tactical information of the Corps (6). Approximately S among tanks were observed by XV Corps troops but none were reported in action (21).

2 April, the 636th TD Re, stold to Lith Ared Div, moved up and began to pass through the 3d and 45th Divs. The 14th Ared Div destroyed 3 BP gums and the 3d Div destroyed another (48).

3 April, CO and 8-4 of Arad Section, Seventh Aray, visited Group CP and conferred with the CO on the subject of vehicles for TD units and on the merch of the 14th Arad Div. Group CD accompanied these officers to IV Corps (54). 636th TD Be destroyed one tank or SP gun while supporting CCB, 14th Arad Div (69).

4 April, the air in support of IV Corps attacked 7 tanks and claimed 4 destroyed. 5-4, 776th TD Rs, visited the Group CP, reference captured vehicles (87). The 14th Arad Div destroyed 3 tanks and the 106th Cav Group liquidated a Mk IV (92).

O51100, Group GP displaced forward to LCHR (#315565), closing into the new area at 051314B. Distance traveled was 47 miles (103). The 636th TD Bm destroyed a German SP gun during the day. The 191st Tank Bm destroyed 3 tanks (112).

6th April, S-3, Ared Section of Army, came to Group CP on the subject of TD daily reports (124). The 14th Ared Div encountered a group of 2 SP guns and 5 Mk V tanks which were destroyed by friendly tank fire. In addition 2 SP's were captured, having been abandoned previously. 2 abandoned tanks were found and destroyed by 45th Div (135).

7th April the Group CF displaced forward to MUNTERSDACH (M4292), a distance of 39 miles (148). CF closed in the old location at 11008 and opened at 20NTERSDACH at 14458. Group personnel sided in treatment and evacuation of 7 civilian casualties, two of which

for fatalities (150). During the day tanks and SF guns, musbering in excess of 20, there is action against IV Corps troops, of which the following were destroyed: 645 TD Ba, 1 SP gan; 636 TD Ba, 3 tanks; 601st TD Ba, 2 tanks; 14th Arad Mv, 7 tanks and 2 SF guns. It addition, aircraft supporting the IV Corps attacked 6 tanks and 2 SF guns in the vicinity of STEINACH and reportedly destroyed 2 tanks, and 45th Div destroyed 2 tanks (164).

# April, the 3rd Div surrounded a group of 10 Mk V tanks in the vicinity of STEIWAGH and liquidated them or forced the crews to destroy them (180). 601st TD En claimed to have destroyed 3 of this total. Supporting aircraft destroyed one tank in addition.

9th April, the billeting party, 5th TD Group, selected billets at BAD REUHAUS (N774-940). The main body followed, closing the eld CP at 1100 and opening CP in the new location at 1434. Distance traveled was 35 miles (199). 2 German deserters were evacuated by Group Asst 3-3 to Corps PWS. The 14th Armd Div destroyed 2 SP guns and mir claimed a th (212).

10 April, Colonel L.E. Jacoby, CO, 5th TD Group, was presented the Croix de Guerre with one palm and the Legion of Honor in grade of Chevelier for exceptional military service during the operation of the liberation of FRANCE. Presentation was made by French officers in the neme of General DeCaulle in a ceresony at XV Corps Headquarters. (218). There was no emeny armor reported in contact with XV Corps troops on this date (232).

Il April, Opens Instant #172, Hq, XV Corps, directed that the attack be continued SE in the XV Corps zone (243). There was no armor contacted by XV Corps but civilian and PK statements indicated the presence of at least two tanks in HASSFURT, at that time about 10 Km sheed of advance elements (247).

12 April, the Group billeting party departed to the vicinity of RBEFN (0/187705) and selected billets in preparation for the move on the following day (256). Open Instance \$173 directed the continuation of the attack (260). The situation remained fluid and only one enemy tank was reported in the Corps sector which was destroyed by 14th Arad Div (270). Reports from civilian sources placed an additional 4 - 12 tanks in the sector of 14th Arad Div.

13 April, Group CP displaced forward to MHENN, closing the old CF at 1100 and opening the new at 1338. Matence travelled was 42 miles (278). Enemy armor was active in
the area of BANBURG. 25 to 30 enemy tenks or SP's were reported in that vicinity. Of
this number 21 were claimed destroyed by the following units: 14th Arad Div - 1, the
191st Tk Bm - 11, Arty - 2, and 156th Cav Gp - 7 (289).

14 April, 5th TD Gp received Opes Instas \$176, Hq. XV Corps, which directed the Gorps to continue the attack to the SE and capture the NURNEERG (incl.) - BAYREUTH (excl) Autobaha (309). No change in mission was given to 5th TD Gp. The 645th TD En, supporting the 45th Div destroyed 2 enemy tanks and air supporting the Corps reported the destruction of 2 tanks (310).

15 April, the advance party moved forward to the vicinity of BAMBERG and selected a new CP. The CP closed in EBERN at 0940 and all elements arrived in BANBERG (0/269504) by 1520 (319). The distance traveled was 25.4 miles. Note than 20 tanks and SP's were encountered by the 14th Arad Div, of which 12 tanks and 2 MP's were destroyed. Close support air claimed the destruction of 2 tanks (325).

16 April, the attack continued and 2 more tanks were destroyed by the 14th Armi Div. 2 SP's were claimed by air action (346).

17 April, Open Instant \$1.77, Mg IV Corps, directed the attack of IV Corps directly south on NURBERGO. There was no change in the mission of the 5th TD Gp (349). The Group GP displaced forward to EHLANGEN (0/364169), closing into the new GP at 1305. Distance traveled was 27.3 miles (357). There were small groups of tanks encountered during the day. 14th Arad My destroyed 1 87 gun, the 45th Div and 645th TD Bn one tank each, and the 3d Inf Div 2 tanks (365).

## IMADEE

18th April, 6924 TO Bm (SF - M-36), atchd to 42d Inf Div, joined IV Corps. The Gy 18th April, 6924 TO Bm and acquainted the battalion GO with the TO policies of IV Corps (377). Enemy armor contact was limited to the destruction of I SF guns like mere attempting a delaying action. 2 were destroyed by the 645th TD Bm, I by the last TD Bm, and I by the 14th Armod Div. The 645th TD Bm shot down a Panserfacet-Civing Storeh out-plane (385).

19th April the 636th TD Bn lost an X-36 scapletely burned to enemy bascoka fire.

Lether destroyer was damaged by a German grenade. The only armored activity was the

Lestruction of one SP gun by the 45th Div (406).

20th April, the Armored Officer of Seventh Army conferred with the Group Commander on the problem of replacement tracks and vehicles for TD units (414). The GO and S-2 visited the review of XV Corps troops in the Adolf Hitler Place at MUNNBERG. 14th Armd Div Gestroped 2 SP guns (431).

21st April, the advance party moved forward to the vicinity of SCHWABACH and selected a new CF. The GP closed in the old location at 1326 and opened at SCHWABACH (0/394864) at 1914. Distance traveled was 27.8 miles (444). 601st TD Bm, atchd to 3d Inf Blv, respected to Army at 210200. The enemy suffered the loss of 2 tanks and 2 SP's destroyed by the 14th Arms Blv (449).

22 April, 20 - 30 tanks and SP's were observed in the IV Corps sector. The two reports of destruction were of 2 Mk IV tanks and 1 SP gum by the 636th TD Bm, and one tank of unknown type by Corps arty (474).

231120 April, the 14th Arad Div passed to central of III Corps. 636th TD Dn reverted to XV Corps control under 5th TD Gp (491). At 231710, 5th TD Gp received an order to assemble 636th TD Dn at CRONHEIE (7/1359) prepared to move to rejain 36th Div. CO, 5th MD Gp, ordered the 636th TD Dn to assemble at the designated location, farmishing route, IP, and convoy number. The CO, 636th TD Dn, visited the Group CP and received the order at 18028 (494). A tanks were observed in the XV Corps sector, of which I was destroyed by the enemy. The 106th Cev also reported receiving SP fire late in the afternoon (497).

24 April, 5th TD Gp received Opes Insine #183, IV Corps, which atchd 20th Arad Ddv (so atchd TD Bn) to the KV Corps (503). It further directed the continuation of the attack in a SE direction, to cross the KNAU RIVER, selse a bridgehead, and be prepared to advance SE on Corps order. There was no change of mission for 5th TD Gp. 241630, lisison officer, 636th TD Bn, reported in to Group GP with the report that the battalion closed into the assembly area at 241200, less 6 K-36's which closed in before dark (512). He enemy armor was reported in the XV Corps sector. 692d TD Bn destroyed a ME 109, which was strafing the column of "C" Company, by .50 caliber fire from a tank destroyer.

25 April, 60 8th MD Group, III Corps, visited the CP and conferred with the Gp Condr (524). The 5th TD Gp arranged for a recommalssance company officer from the 636th TD Sn to be placed on special duty with the 645th TD Sn to cover a shortage of officers in the Ron Co of 645th TD Sn. (534) At 252100, the 636th TD Sn was ordered to move without delay to the IXI Corps sector preparatory to re-attachment to the 36th Div (538). The billeting party, Hq 5th TD Gp, went forward to the vicinity of MCMHEIM (T/2831) preparatory to the contemplated move of the GP on 26th April (525). During the day 7 tanks were reported by civilian and FF sources, and some SP fire was encountered in the advance to the BCMAU NIVER. In addition, the 692d TD En destroyed a FK IV, 2 helf-tracks, and a towed AT gun while supporting a special armor and infantry detachment (541).

26 April, GP 5th TB Gp moved forward from SCHRABACH to WARCHING (T/3231). The old GP closed at 1030 and the new GP epened at 1240. Distance traveled was 41.6 miles (551). The 636th TB Bn began movement to IXI Corps at 261000B as per ltr movement order, Hq Seventh Army, dated 25 April (562). Enemy self-propelled guns were active during the day, harrassing the crossings of the DOMAU RIVER in the sectors of 42d and 45th Divisions. Air reported and took under fire 3 - 4 tanks just south of the DOMAU RIVER (568)

27th April, Group 3-4 went on S/D to G-4, XV Corps, to sid in regulating traffic he excessing of the EXMAU RIVER by Corps troops and 20th Ared Div (574). Opes Instead as directed the continuation of the attack toward MUNCUEN. There was no change in the naise of 5th TD Gp. 6 - 8 tanks and SPIs were reported in action against or observed M Corps, of which I tank was claimed by close air support. (593)

28th April, 3 PW s were taken by the guard at 0100. Gp CP closed at WARCHING at 1352 and moved 25 miles south to STAURELN (388164), crossing the Danube River at 1500 and opening the new CP at 1645 (607). Enemy armor was inactive, only one tank was reported observed (613). The 3d Riv (601 TD Bn stohd) came under control of EV Corps, to aid in the

29th April, one officer PN was taken at 0535 (616). Opns Instns \$188, Hq XV Corpe, furnished the details of the attack on MUNCHEN (617). In order to keep up with the repidly moving situation, the Group CP displaced 22 miles forward to AlCHACH (509898) (630). The CP closed in the old location at 1334 and opened at 1542. The 42d Mr destroyed one

30 April at 1605 Group CP again displaced forward, this time to DACHAU (745690), a distance of 23 miles. The CP closed in the new location at 20178 (651).

Total Pars for the month taken and evacuated by Group Hq and Hq Co: 10, including l officer.

The dentists of 5th TD Gp worked on personnel of the 601st and 645th TD Ens for 19 and 11 days respectively. At the end of the period, the dentists were preparing to leave

The chaptain of 5th TD Gp was atchd to 645th TD Ba for the month of April and rendered services to personnel of that unit and neighboring infentry troops.

For the period covered, the CO, 5th TD Gp, served as AT Officer for XV Gorps. During this period XV Corps is credited with knocking out 100 tanks and 27 SP guns. Since XV Corps became operational 3116008 July 1944, the cumulative total of tanks and SF guns destroyed by all troops, assigned, attached, or in support of IV Corps totals 1148. Of these 1148 tanks and SF guns destroyed, 89 were eliminated by 5th TD Gp and 773d TD Bm. while on temporary detected service with V Corps during the period 17 - 22 August 1944.

Daily TD Reports, 601st, 645th, and 692d TD Bn's are exclosed to show total destruc-tion of enemy material by these bettalions.
