

Left Naguillan, P.I., and arrived at Lipa, P.I., 1 Dec 45.
Departed Lipa, P.I. 12 Dec 45 and arrived Manila P.I. 12 Dec 45.
Departed Manila aboard USAT "BRAZIL" for US 13 Dec 45.
Arrived US (San Francisco Port of Debarkation) 30 Dec 45.
Debarked USAT "BRAZIL" 1030 hrs. 30 December 1945 and arrived
Camp Stoneman, California 1830 hrs. 30 December 1945.

The 632d Tank Destroyer Battalion was inactivated 1 January 1946 per Letter, The Adjutant General, War Department, Washington 25, D.C., AG 322 (20 Nov 45) OB-I-SPMOU-M, dated 26 November 1945. Eight Officers, one Warrant Officer and seven Enlisted Men were retained as cadre to inactivate this unit. Their names will appear on the final roster of this organization being prepared this date.
