1. a. (1) See current Intelligence reports and summaries.
 (2) Artillery fire received in IV Corps Area indicates possible large caliber guns emplaced on TAKIWA JIMA.
 (3) Results of Obs mission on TAKIWA JIMA (TA 0276V2 and 0275AB)
 (a) Observed at TA 0276V2 a number of holes in cliff facing west.
 (b) Observed at TA 0276V3 on top of hill, two camouflaged huts back among brush, one can seen who had quickly. Other holes camouflaged with brush.
 (4) For main fire field see Opn Overlay.
- b. (1) 20th Armd Gp will organize Task Force to execute reconnaissance in force of TAKIWA JIMA; mop up and render useless caves and Jap defensive works on the Island and destroy enemy encountered; will maintain communications with the IV Corps base station.
 (2) CO, 720 Amph Tank Bn (- one platoon) will land in first wave and support the movement south to Phase Line No. 1 (See Opn Overlay). The platoon CO, 3 720 Amph Tank Bn will move offshore along western coast of the Island and support the land movement by flanking fire and by neutralization of high ground on the southwestern tip of the island.
 (3) 536th Amph Trac Bn in area reserve will have available one company for movement to TAKIWA JIMA on two hours notice.
 (4) Air cover and strikes will be effected under control of LFACGUs.
2. a. CO B, 720 Amph Trac Bn, reinf by BN Command, Maintenance and Medical Detachment, operating as part of the 20th Armd Gp Task Force will move by LVT convoy to assembly area KOTORU CHIBA; execute reconnaissance in force of TAKIWA JIMA; mop up and render useless caves and defensive positions; destroy enemy encountered.
- b. Movement to assembly areas:
 (1) If - CR Route No. 1 and Taro Street.
 (2) Route - Hwy 20, 24, and 16 to Assembly Area TA 0082.
 (3) Order of March - CO B, BN Command; Med Dets; BN Maint.
 (4) Interval - 50 yards.
- c. (1) Land on TAKIWA JIMA at 0-hour and proceed in LVTs to phase line No. 1 (Opn Overlay) and dismount.
 (2) Attack the village of TAKIWA and high ground beyond with two platoons abreast.
- d. Rate of landing: 23 April 1945, R-hour 1000L.

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3. a. CO A, 71C Amph Trac Bn will remain present position, continue unloading cargo over 111' distance; defend base station from attack from land, air or water.
- b. CO B, 71C Amph Trac Bn will land on 111' distance and 111' in second wave, follow and protect Amph tanks. In event of phase line "B" 1 and attack, with two platoons abreast, the village of "B" 1, 111' and the high ground beyond; mop up and render useless caves and defensive positions and destroy enemy encountered.
- c. Med Det. will follow CO B to Phase Line 1, establish fwd aid station and furnish evacuation LVTs.
- d. Maint will follow CO B to Phase Line 1, establish maintenance shop.
- e. (1) Air strikes through BN Command.
 (2) CO B will operate mine detectors.
 (3) All troops will reembark before dusk 15 April 69.
 (4) All troops are responsible for their own security.
4. SUPPLY
- a. Class I
 (1) C & R rations for two days.
 (2) Water supply for two days.
- b. Class IV.
 (1) Complete basic load fuel aboard LVTs.
 (2) Complete basic load lubricants aboard LVTs.
- c. Class V.
 (a) Two w/f all weapons.
 (b) Demolitions as provided.
5. a. Current CP
 b. Rear CP with CO A
 Fwd CP afloat with second wave.
