



Rimling

On 2 October 1944, the Battalion, under the command of Lt. Col. Dwight E. Moorhead, marched to the Nisidia, Italy staging area and there boarded American U.S. Navy LST's for the voyage to France.

After two days aboard the small, weaving craft, the unit arrived at Marseille, France in the evening of 4 October 1944. Debarking immediately, movement was made to an assembly area in the vicinity of Septemes and Aix, France.

Bivouacs were once again set up and time relegated to the role of waiting for orders which would start the Battalion's movement to the north for a new attachment to a division.

On 20 October 1944, the combat vehicles, half-tracks and destroyers, complete with their assigned crews, were loaded on trains to start the shipment North.

The morning of 23 October 1944, the remainder of the Battalion moved out of the Septemes-Aix, France area enroute to their new assembly point, Epinal, France. After three days travel, in which time 499 miles were covered, with bivouacs enroute occupied at Vienne and Dole, France, the Battalion arrived in the vicinity of Nomexy, France, northwest of Epinal, France, at 1400 hours the afternoon of 26 October 1944.

Unloading the combat vehicles, which had arrived in Epinal by train, checks of those vehicles and maintenance of the other wheeled vehicles was the next step.

The day of 29 October 1944, the unit marched to the vicinity of Luneville, France and on 30 October 1944 went into positions for operations in that vicinity in direct support of the 44th Infantry Division and as an attached unit of the U. S. XV Corps.

Attachments for the three infantry regiments of the Division found Company "A" in support of the 71st, Company "B" with the 524th, Company "C" reinforcing the 114th and Reconnaissance Company providing Division Reconnaissance.

Activity, in weather that ranged from cold, whipping winds to rain and snow, found the Battalion unloading their powerful new guns with heavy barrages against enemy positions aiding the infantry elements in their drive on the vital communications center of Sarrebourg, France. After three weeks of grueling conflict, centered in the vicinity of Avricourt and St. George, France, the Battalion and the assaulting infantry elements closed on Sarrebourg.

On 21 November 1944, Company "A", supporting the 71st Infantry Regiment drove into that city effecting its capture. Company "C" went to the northwest in support of the 106th Cavalry Group, guarding the left flank of the Seventh Army and protecting the left flank of the Second French Armored Division in their advance towards Strasbourg, France. Company "B" moved to the left of Sarrebourg then on to the north and east were the Second Platoon of Company "B" led the attack of the 324th Infantry Regiment through the Saverne Gap. Although one of these destroyers was knocked out by enemy anti-tank fire the platoon continued the attack knocking out many enemy vehicles and capturing many prisoners.

On 24 November 1944, while Company "C" was engaged in operations North of Drulingen, France with the 106th Cavalry Group, the enemy launched a counterattack against the flank of the 44th Infantry Division, forcing the Cavalry screen to withdraw from the towns of Hirschland, Weyer, Eywiller and Rauwiller and threatening the forward command post of the 44th Infantry Division and the Division supply lines.

To halt this threat to the XV Corps flank the 114th Infantry Regiment with Company "A" in direct support were rushed into position to the left of Company "C" and Company "B" was brought back through the Saverne Gap to reinforce the 71st Infantry Regiment which was being attacked in the vicinity of Rauwiller, France.

On 25 November 1944 in the vicinity of Schalbach, France, the enemy launched his all-out armored, infantry assault in the 114th Infantry Sector, where Company "A" of the Battalion was in position. In fanatical assaults, the enemy infantry and armor bore down on positions of that Regiment which was covered by the First Platoon of Company "A". Directing the fire of their destroyers on the enemy elements, this platoon, together with the Second and Third Platoons of Company "A", which had immediately moved

over to the threatened sector, destroyed five enemy tanks and inflicted severe losses to the enemy in personnel thereby forcing the Germans to withdraw. In this action, the destroyer crews in the First Platoon, led by Sergeant Carl Gunnarson and Sergeant Joseph Gilbert were credited with the destruction of all five of the enemy tanks.

During this enemy attack, Sergeant Arthur Mygland was killed in action while rescuing a fellow soldier of a supporting unit and First Lieutenant Harold O. Weisweaver and Corporal Clarence

A. Larsen lost their lives when their vehicle struck a mine while engaged in reconnaissance. Previously, on 21 November 1944, Captain Paul R. Brunt, Commander of Reconnaissance Company, was killed accidentally with First Lieutenant Vernon F. Hovey Jr., taking command of that organization.

Operations of the Battalion then progressed through the mud and rain towards the North in the vicinity of Montbronn, France with the destroyers in direct support of the infantry attacks.

As the 44th Division approached the Maginot Line the enemy opposition stiffened with enemy armor supporting the enemy defenses. During an enemy counterattack on Wiesviller, France at dawn, Corporal Sandberg of Company "C" gave the Krauts the surprise of their life when he knocked out three enemy half-tracks and an assault gun with six rounds fired, thereby breaking up the counter-attack.

Another savage counterattack was launched on 10 December 1944 at Maierhof by the enemy in an effort to hold his Maginot Line defenses. In this action platoons from Company "A" and Company "B" stopped the attacks of German panzers and continued on to take the town of Petit Rederching, but in the course of action, Sergeant Robert Elijah and Corporal Arnold Freelander were killed when their destroyers were knocked out. When Staff Sergeant Eric A. Antonson brought his platoon of Company "C" in to assist in the action he was killed by enemy artillery fire.

At this point, further advances of the Division were held up by the enemy holding Fort Simserhof, one of the most elaborate of the Maginot fortifications. After much detailed planning and reconnaissance the guns of this fort were neutralized by direct fire of Company "A's" destroyers, thereby enabling the 71st Infantry Regiment to complete its capture. Change in command of Company "A" at this time found First Lieutenant Burnell F. Peter becoming Commanding Officer when Captain Willis F. Cole Jr., was hospitalized.

On 19 December 1944, the opening of the German offensive in the Ardennes, the Seventh Army was assigned the mission of covering additional territory, previously covered by the American Third Army which was called to the North to aid in stemming the German attack. On 21 December 1944, the Battalion was given orders to move to the left of its present position to the vicinity of Sarreguemines, France and there to occupy positions which were vacated by the departing Third Army units.

In a night movement on 21 December, the date of the Battalion's third anniversary as the 776th Tank Destroyer Battalion and making its second spent on overseas service, the unit left its present location and were stationed in their new positions at daylight on 22 December 1944.

In this month, Staff Sergeant Henry A. Wiese and William J. Clark, Reconnaissance Company, were commissioned as Second Lieutenants by battlefield appointment.

With the setting in of winter and the fast approaching end of 1944, the components of the Battalion, Company "A", "B", and "C" and Reconnaissance Company were engaged in action in the vicinity

of the villages of Rimling, Sarreguemines, Woelfling and Gros Rederching, France.

The pitch black evening of 31 December 1944, the enemy again staged a fanatical, crazed attack attempting to break our positions but were beaten back incurring very heavy losses.

During the early days of 1945, the enemy continued to attack in our sector to be repeatedly thrown back. During this period, in

bitterly cold weather and snow covered terrain, the destroyer crews were necessarily constantly on the alert for enemy armored attacks. While fighting to hold Rimling, France against one of these armored attacks, Lieutenant Britz and his crew of Company "A" knocked out the first Jagdtiger tank ever KO'd on the Western Front. During a night counterattack by enemy armor, the same month, Lieutenant Binsz and his crew of Company "C" knocked out two Mark IV tanks in the middle of the night at a range of 200 yards.

In mid-January 1945, the operations in the Battalion's sector relegated to a defensive, holding role. In uncomfortable weather, that found the temperature always low and the snow ever prevalent, the Battalion stayed in stationary firing positions in support of the infantry elements. Billets consisted of a few scarce abandoned houses and dug-outs near the destroyers.

For a period of two and one half months the Battalion maintained this dismal existence performing continuous firing missions and always on the alert to beat back the enemy should he attempt another offensive in our sector. The period, though devoid of offensives, was marked by casualties. Corporal Ferdinand J. Schmidt, Company "A", died of wounds received on 5 December 1944 with Corporal Stanley E. Hams killed in action on 8 January 1945. Other casualties in the Battalion found two officers and twenty five enlisted men wounded during this period.

Further changes within the Battalion found Major William O. Shirley Jr., leaving the Battalion for school in the United States with Major Rowland R. Martin becoming Battalion Executive Officer, Captain Louis J. Wadle taking over Operations Officer duties, Captain William C. Weir, Commander of Company "C" was added to the staff as Intelligence Officer with First Lieutenant Donald B. Alfreds taking over command of Company "C". Captain John C. Welch assumed the Supply Officer's position as Captain Jess L. Cusick Jr., took command of Company "A" replacing First Lieutenant Burnell F. Peter who left the Battalion for duty in Seventh Army Headquarters. Battlefield commissions in December, January, February and the first two weeks of March had elevated First Sergeant Robert Bartley, Company "B", Staff Sergeant John C. Britz, Company "A", First Sergeant Russell L. Braden, Company "C", Staff Sergeant Ervin H. Cremers, Reconnaissance Company, Staff Sergeant Louis M. LaCassie, Company "A", Staff Sergeant Walter A. Binsz, Company "C", and First Sergeant Robert E. Bunce, Reconnaissance Company to the rank of Second Lieutenant.

On 15 March 1945, the Battalion was detached from the 44th Infantry Division and moved from their present stations of Rimling, Rohrbach, Gros Rederching, Singling and Kalhausen, France to the vicinity of Omersheim, Germany and Ensheim, Germany becoming attached to the 63d Infantry Division in that area for the assault on the Siegfried Line.

The Battalion, with the mission of directly supporting this Division in its attack to break through the Siegfried defenses so that armor could enter the Saar-Palatinate region from the South, had Company "A" in support of the 254th Infantry Regiment, Company "B" in mobile reserve with the 253d Infantry Regiment, and Company "C" supporting the 255th Infantry Regiment.

In the dawn hours of 16 March 1945, with Companies "A" and "C" in position and to quote the Presidential Citation given these two companies "in a terrain highly unfavorable for attacking armor, fortified with all the ingenuity the enemy could command over a period of years, and, defended stubbornly by a desperate foe, the destroyers of these companies repeatedly occupied exposed firing positions and brought devastating direct fire upon the two main belts of the Siegfried Line until the fortifications were neutralized or destroyed. For sixty continuous hours the gallant destroyer crews,

without rest or relief, fought in their open turreted, lightly armored vehicles. Deafened by the continuous firing of their own guns and shaken by the constant pounding of enemy artillery, they fired, at point blank ranges, 2450 rounds of 90mm ammunition into strongly built pillboxes of Germany's last line of defense. Only darkness permitted the withdrawal from the direct support by enemy bombardment, infiltration, and the necessity for night maneuver, reloading, refueling and maintenance made rest impossible. Due to the high rate of fire frequent cooling periods for the guns had to be

allowed and in these periods the crews continued their support of the infantry, firing the 50 caliber anti-aircraft machine gun from the exposed deck of the destroyers against enemy infantry. Moving with the leading assault units and seriously restricted in maneuver by the nature of the terrain and defenses, the destroyers were dangerously exposed to direct artillery, bazooka, anti-tank grenade and sniper fire. Three high velocity anti-tank guns were knocked out during the course of the action. All destroyers engaged were

forced to beat off the frequent enemy infantry attacks with fragmentation grenades and small arms. One destroyer was hit with bazooka fire and burned and several others were hit. With every possible advantage of observation the enemy was able to maintain a continuous and frequently heavy artillery and mortar fire on the destroyers. His prepared fires at night were heavy and accurate. Every destroyer was damaged to some degree and two direct hits were suffered. Wounded crew members refused evacuation and stayed with their under-manned destroyers. With unfaltering courage and

the utmost devotion to duty under the most adverse tactical and terrain conditions, Companies "A" and "C" aggressively maintained their direct support of the infantry until the battered enemy was forced to withdraw and the mission was accomplished." Eleven men were wounded in these three days and S/Sgt Alvin K. Waggoner and Sgt Arthur B. Rossland killed.

In supporting this heroic attack, Headquarters Company trains, gasoline and ammunition, supplied the firing companies, displaying a heroic and unselfish devotion to duty.

The afternoon of 21 March 1945, the Battalion was at long last afforded a rest. Detached from the 65d Infantry Division the unit moved back and assembled in the vicinity of Richling, France.

After only four days relief from the front lines, on 25 March 1945, once again attached to the 44th Infantry Division, the Battalion moved out on a long road march to Fischbach, Germany, there to prepare to go back into action.

During the month of March 1945 Captain William A. Sturman, joined the Battalion replacing Captain Sidney Edelson as Battalion Surgeon.

Traveling the entire night the Battalion arrived at that location, Fischbach, Germany, at 0800 hours, 26 March 1945. Enroute the convoy was strafed by a lone Nazi plane, causing no materiel damage but wounded Captain Kirk A. Dutton, Battalion Dentist.

From Fischbach, Germany the Battalion moved out with the 44th Infantry Division and crossed the smoke-covered Rhine River on a treadway bridge below Worms, Germany.

With the Reich slowly crumbling, the Battalion aided in the capture of Mannheim, Germany then drove to the outskirts of Heidelberg, Germany. Changing direction to the North the Unit went to Fohrbach, Ehrbach and working with the 10th Armored Division and the 44th Infantry Division went to Ulm, Germany and then crossed the Danube River.

The Wehrmacht on its last legs and with Germany broken into small pieces with each town we entered a spectacle of white flags hung out in surrender, the Battalion entered Austria on 30 April 1945 as V—E day seemed to be only a matter of hours away.

Continuing on to Pflach, Reutte, Bichlbach and Ehrwald, Austria, the Battalion came to a halt on 8 May 1945 as victory was proclaimed in simultaneous announcements by President Harry S. Truman, Prime Minister Winston Churchill and Marshal Joseph Stalin.

After completing 550 days of actual combat, which had found the Battalion fighting in three theaters, Africa, Italy, Europe, through five major campaigns, Tunisian, Rome-Arno (Italy), Naples-Foggia (Italy), Rhineland (France and Germany) and Central Europe, this day, 8 May 1945, was one of thanksgiving and proudness. Thanksgiving that at long last the dreaded Nazi regime was rid from the roles of mankind and proudness in that the Battalion the "776th", had inscribed its greatness unto the military annals of our Country.
