REPORT OF OPERATIONS FOR MONTH OF MAY 1945

The month spened with the Battalien attached to the 88th Infantry Division and further attached to the 752 Tank Bn. (sperations only). Battalian C.P. lested at 289892, "A" Company located at 071011, "B" Company located at 288106, "G" Company located at 484985, Ren. Company located at 280803, and Hqs. Company (Bn. Rear) located at 289984. Battalian driving morth with the Division toward 20080 and 6005004. The 88th Infantry Division protected the right flank and the 10th Houston Street Plank.

Buttalien maintained limicon with 752 Tank Sa. Que Ron. Platoon attached to each gum Sempany. Rost. minus vicinity Sattalien C.P.

"A" Sompany attached 860th Infantry Regiment, protected Division left flank, moved on parallel redds toward ASIAGO (071011). "B" Company, attached 881st Infustry Regiment, attacked north to help seize PRINCLANA and set up defenses and progage to move morthwest into 20200. Company engaged a convey of enemy vehicles and herse drawn earts, inflicting heavy ensualties and capturing an unknown number of PW's. 1 RM mounded in action. Rem. Plateon, ettached, captured 30 PW's and knocked out 1 mechine gum. In this action 9 Americans, who had been in the hands of friendly partisons, were recaptured. "C" Company attached 349th Infantry Regiment helped seize CARFORA and attacked morth toward FELTRE. Armor of this task ferce was held up by & blown bridge. Company year, fullewing this task force, was engaged in a fire fight with the enemy vicinity of CARSUPA. Enemy was caught in a narrow street and engaged with cross fire of four edl. .50 machine guns and one 57 me gun. Several casualties were inflicted on the enemy and numerous PH's taken who stated that they had never been under such a terrific concentration of fire. Combat efficiency of the Battalion remained very sahisfactory. Results of the day's operations were the sapture of ever 50 PW's, knocking out 1 machine gun, and the recovery of 9 Americans. Companies assisted in the attacks of three regiments during the period.

2 MAY 1945

"A" Company neved north to assembly area vicinity ARSE. "O" Company meved from PELTRE northwest through PARSASO to a point at 270175 where a bridge was blown. Enoug across the river was beginged and approximately 18 PW's were taken by the force. G.O. of Company, Senting a by-pass with G.O., Company "A", 752 Tank En., took 195 PW's out of Describes vicinity PRESA, 272181. In the day's operations the Battalien accounted for at least 25 enoug dead and assisted in taking approximately 200 PW's before constitute of heatilities in Italy were tangement.

\$ May 1945

"A" Company with one plateen of Rem. Company attached remained vicinity ARSIE, preparing for the next move. "C" Company with one plateen of Rem. Company attached formed part of a RCT which moved toward MERNEER PASS to take up positions in that vicinity. Results of operations, Anttalian was represented in RCT by one Company of TD's and one plateen of Rem. Company.

4 May 1945

"A" Company remained at ARSIE performing first echolen maintenance and smaiting further movement. "B" Company moved with the BELST Infantry Regiment toward TRENTO. Company in position at each and of LAGO DI CALDONAZZO. Distring of German soldiers is taking place. "C" Company remained attached to \$40th Infantry Regiment Combat Team, moved to BRESSANORZ.

5 May 1945

Battalies remained in position preparing to move and performing first scholes maintenance.

6 May 1945

Battalian C.P. moved to 962685. "A" Company moved from 292172 to 045480. Balance of Battalian remained in position.

7 May 1945

Ren, Goupeny moved from 162165 to 162660, Eq. Company (Re. Rear) moved from 280040 to 963665. Remainder of Buttalian, no change. Results of operations, Battalian continued to assist in rounding up of German FW's.

8 May 1945

Period was quiet. Asttalion continued to assist in rounding up forman PW's and equipment.

14 May 1945

"G" Company furnished a security guard for 700 88 troops and assisted in the espture of MAYER, sousin of RIMCLER.

15 May 1945

Day was quiet, Bettalien remained in position performing first scholen maintenance and amaiting artists to move.

16 May 1945

"C" Company moved to MERANO, A-840192. Second Plateon given the mission of guarding redistribution Center (enemy) 1 mile west of MERANO. One plateon Rem. Company reinferred was furnished to guard servey of gold to NOMA.

17 May 1945

"B" Company, C.P. moved to vicinity RIVA, second platoen to ALDENA, third platoen remained at BORGO. So other change in lecations.

18 May to 26 May 1945

Period remained quiet. Companies performing maintenance, doing guard duty in terms and rounding up German PW's.

27 May 1945

Sempanies remained in position. "G" Company rist squad of 1 officer and 18 calisted men assisted in the capture of BUCHARD, Presch East Propaganda Minister.

28 May to 51 May 1945

Period was quiet, Companies continued with mission of rounding up German FW's. Intelion propering to move to LAGO DA GARDA.

Resume of Action during recent operations:

than 8,000 remail in proparation for the attack on BOLOGHA. Battalian fired more than 8,000 remail in proparation for the attack. Battalian minus "C" Company attached to \$4th Infantry Mivision. "C" Company remained attached to Legama Group (Italian). On 18 April the enemy's defenses were breaking and friendly troops continued their advance. Entire Battalian moved to BOLOGHA \$1 April 1945 and organised a perimeter defense. Battalian relieved from attached \$4th Infantry Division and attached to 88th Infantry Division on 82 April 1945. "A" Company attached with one plateon of Ren. So was attached to the \$50th Inf Regt, "B" Co attached with one plateon of Ren. So was attached to the \$51st Inf Regt, and "C" Co attached with one plateon of Ren. Co was attached to the \$49th Inf Regt. Moving rapidly northward, the enemy magin retreat and hadly disorganized. The Battalian on the Efra April 1945 assisted in the conjure of approximately 9,000 PM's. Battalian reached the FO RIVER and the way and assisted state of the \$10th Infantry Regt in drive on VERONA. "C" Company or support of "A" Sempany 762 Sank Ru. dreve into VICHELA during the morning of 28 April 1945 after a fire fight in thich six friendly tanks were kneeted out by bassookas. Soising objective at river crossing just west of FONTANIVA, 29 April 1945, "A" Company destroyed numerous vehicles, killed approximately 70 enemy and assisted in capturing 50 PM's.

With the essetion of hestilities 2. May 1945 "6" Go with one plateen of Rom. Go attached formed part of a ROT which moved toward ERMETE PASS to occupy that vicinity.

Battelien assisted in guard duty in towns and rounding up and disarming German soldiers.

The period ended with the Bettalien at LAKE GARDA expecting and awaiting ment orders to the United States or an active theater.
