The Co was rold of atchest fr the 30th Inf Regt & ordered to assemble in their former Position near Mendt. April 10 h5-The 2nd Flt wichd to the 93re Ron Sqdn & moved to vicinity of Hennef. To departed to Neiderottorsbach at 0700 hrs & arrived at Wendt at 0800 hrs & awaited further instructions. The 1st & 3rd Flts atchd to Combat Command "B", 13th Armord Div, 2nd Flt atchd to 93rd "on Sqdn of the 13th Armord Div. All elements jumped off to move forward to the vicinity of Selgburg, Ear, o CP OP remained in Slegburg which was not completely cleared. April 12 45-The 1st & 3rd Flts discovered two Sham guns early in the day. One was alresdy out & the other in good condition but not manuad. This one was rendered useless by Sgt Lynch who placed a charge in the breech & bl.w it. Sgts Clavier & Kulps, with their TDs moved to Urbach, Ger. & Fired 19 rds & flushed out about 400 Germans. The prisoners were turned over to the Inf & marched to the rear. The 1st & 3rd Plts left Eil about 1500 hrs and bivouached. Intermittent morter & shell fire all day but no casualites. Secouse of the intense art firs the Co Co GP moved back across the Aga River. Shelling of the 2nd Plt area near Lohmar contid. 'o GP GP jd the En. CP Gp in Sieburg, "er at about 1700 hrs & w s bille ted for the night. April 13 45 Ford has been received that the Bn was reld of atchmt fr the 13th Armid Div, effective immediately & is again atom to the 97th Inf "iv. the Co CP Ep moved withe the Regtal CP of the 303d Inf "egt at Pollbruck. The Flts were expected to join the CP Gp in this vicinity on Ili April 45. o Cpstill at Dellbruck awaiting word to join other elements of Co. Co moved forw rd a jd lot a 3rd Plts near Dunamald Ger. & as they entered town the enemy laid down a 15 minute art barrage. Barrage cought & pinned everyone on the street. No casualties as a result but one destroyer was knocked out by a direct hit on the front between the headlights. The Co GP "p moved back to Dellbruck & the knocked out destroyer was left in Dunawald. The 2nd Flt moved to Alterrath Ger. & had to ford stream-no life passingly. The Flt was then reld of atchmt fr 93rd den 5qdn & atchd to Co "G", 620 th TD Bn Firing ontid in all Positions near Burn.
