Co. left temporary bivouac Charleroi, Belg. 1000 hours, arrived new Station bivouac area Lafelt, Belg. 1700 hours. "A" Co. left temporary bivouac area Charleroi, Belg. 1000 hours for Sta. bivouac area 3 Km. E Wytingen, Belg. arrived new Sta. bivouac area 3 Km. E Wytingen 1700 hours. "B" Co. left temporary bivouac area Charleroi, Belg. 1000 hours for new Sta. bivouac area Wytingen, Belg. arrived Wytingen 1700 hours. "C" Co. left temporary bivouac area Charleroi, Belg. 1000 hours for Sta. bivouac area Wytingen. Beg. arrived Wytingen, Belg. 1700 hours. (9 Dec. 1944 Hqs. Co. left Sta. bivouac area Lafelt, Belg. 0530 hours, arrived new Sta. bivouac area Weisten, Belg. 1300 hours. Bn. was transferred from the NINTH US ARMY to the FIRST US ARMY. "A" Co. left Sta. bivouac area 3 Km. E Wytingen, Belg. 0530 hours arrived at new Sta. bivouac area Crombach, Belg. 1300 hours. "B" Co. left Sta. bivouac area Wytingen, Belg. 0530 hours arrived bivouac area Braunlauf, Belg. 1300 hours. "C" Co. left Sta. bivouac area 3 Km. E Wytingen, Belg. 0530 hours arrived new Sta. bivouac area Maldange, Belg. 1300 hours. 11 Dec. 1944 Hqs. Co. plus Med. Det. left Sta. bivouac area Weisten, Belg. 0930 hours arrived at forward CP Eimerscheid, Belg. 1300 hours. "A" Co. left Sta. bivouac area Crombach, Belg. arrived at Manderfeld, Belg. Co. was attached to 14th Cav. Gp. for front line operations. "B" Co. left Braunlauf, Belg. 1300 hours arrived at Winterspelt, Germ. 1600 hours, Co. was attached to the 424 Inf. Reg. for front line operations. "C" Co. left bivouac area Maldange, Belg. 1845 hours arrived new bivouac area Bleialf, Ger. 2200 hours. 16 Dec. 1944 Hqs. Co. plus Med. Det. left forward CP Eimerscheid, Belg. 1300 hours arrived bivouac area Crombach, Belg. 1530 hours forming a rear echelon. 15 Dec. 1944 "A" Co. withdrew from Manderfeld at 1545 hours arrived at Herresbach Belg. 1655 hours. "B" Co. forced to evacuate CP appr. 1500 hours to St. Vith, Belg. arriving at 1930 hours. "C" Co. 16 Dec. 1944 left Bleialf, Germ. at 2100 hours for overnight bivouac area approx. 4 1/2 miles SW Bleialf, Germ. 17 Dec. Hqs. Co. plus Med. Det. 23 EM from Co. "C" joined rear echelon, rear echelon left Crombach, Belg. 1430 hours arrived Houffelize, Belg. 1530 hours, 26 EM joined rear echelon at 1830 hours. 17 Dec. 1944 "A" Co. withdrew from Herresbach, Belg. 1100 hours arrived at Niederemmel, Belg. 1500 hours, Co. moved to Vielsalm to reorganize arrived 1830 hours. 17 Dec. 1944 "B" Co. Company CP withdrew in column with Bn. CP Gp. to vicinity of Vielsalm, Belg. arriving at 2030 hours. 17 Dec. 1944 "C" Co. left overnight bivouac area 4 1/2 miles SW Bleialf, Germ. 0830 hours arrived at Crombach, Belg. 1300 hours, joined rear echelon Hqs. Co. left Crombach, Belg. 1430 hours arrived 2 Km. N Houffelize, Belg. 1530 hours. 18 Dec. 1944 Hqs. Co. plus Med. Det. left Houffelize, Belg. 1500 hours arrived Rondeux, Belg. 1730 hours. 18 Dec. 1944 "A" Co. forced to move and joined rear echelon with elements of "B", and "C" Co. at Rondeux, Belg. 1800 hours. 18 Dec. 1944 CP Gp. with elements of A, B, and C Co. moved to vicinity of Laroche, Belg. arrived at 1800 hours. 18 Dec. 1944 left with rear echelon of Hqs. Co. from bivouac area 2 Km. N Houffelize, Belg. 1500 hours arrived Rondeux, Belg. 1730 hours, equipment from A, B, and C Co. was pooled and issued to the 2 Recon. Platoons of Hqs. Co. for further front line duty, no word from 1st, 2nd and 3rd platoon. 21 Dec. 1944 Hqs. Co. plus Med. Det. left Rondeux, Belg. 0900 hours arrived Ciney, Belg. 1500 hours. 21 Dec. 1944 "A" Co. Road patrol fired on by US Engineers at 0030 hours, none of our men were injured, one engineer killed and one wounded. At 0900 hours patrol fired on by enemy patrol, no casualties. Three Germ. reported killed and several injured, one of our peeps was lost. Left Rondeux, Belg. with elements of Hqs. "B", and "C" Co. 0900 hours, arrived Ciney, Belg. 1500 hours. 22 Dec. 1944 The Bn. left Ciney, Belg. 1100 hours, was held up over night and bivouaced at St. Severin, Belg. 23 Dec. 1944 The Bn. left St. Severin 1000 hours and arrived Sta. bivouac area Esneux, Belg.

The Bn. was attached to the 106th Inf. Div. 12 Dec. 1944 for operation at front.

Three Company Aid men were attached to each Company, and one aid men to each Recon. Platoon during operations
