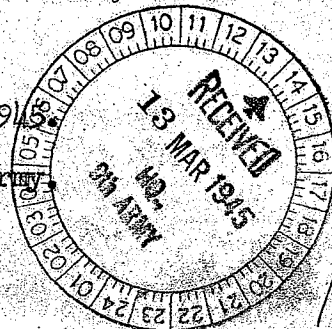

Month of February 1945

1. Unit assigned to NINTH US Army and attached to XIII Corps during the period.
2. Unit served in the capacity of Corps Antitank Section on the staff of the Corps Artillery Commander. After action report of the section was incorporated in the report of the Corps.
3. Unit served in the capacity of Corps Rear Area Security Headquarters. All measures of local and general area security by units in the Corps Rear area were coordinated.
