SUMMARY OF OPERATIONS: 1 October 1944 to 31 October 1944.

(sote: All coordinates listed are found in the ford De Guerre grid system and in the 500 kilometer square V. All letters preceeding operainates in this narrative designate the 100 Km square within the above mentioned area).

To September - Battalien was issued eighteen (18) Gun Motor Carriage, 90-mm, m36. These were broken down to include one per tank destroyer section. Familiarisation, as much as possible, had been completed prior to the issue.

The third plateon of Company "B" was the only element

The third platoon of Company "B" was the only element of the battalion on the line. All others were receiving time for maintenance, recreation, rest and rehabilitation.

Disposition of troops of the battalion were as follows:

"C" Co had been releived of their road blook assignments on this date.

1 Oct 44.- "A" Co demonstrated the new M36 for C Cond "A", 3rd Arad Div. Final arrangements were made and permission received from 0-3; 3rd Arad Div to test-fire the M36 on 2 Oct 44. Location of range, vio WALHEIM (M903354).

2 Oct 44.- All m36's were test-fired by 1200 mours. All guns operative. It was observed that older lots of mamunition cause a large screen of smoke in front of the destroyer. This will, in addition to increasing the difficulties of observation, disclose the position of the gun. Some younds were smokeless and very satisfactory.

Four (4) M-10's from "C" Co went into indirect firing position at (K926369) via BREINIG. Will fire interdictory and horassing missions in vicinity of ESCHEZIEER.

Ammunition allowance for indirect missions for the week beginning Sunday are, 700 ras 90mm HE and 900 rds 3" HE.
"C" Co fired 107 rds 3" HE on indirect missions during the period.

3 Out 44. Second Plateon of "B" Co releived the 3rd Plt of "B" Co. Releif flected at 1700 hours. "B" Co demonstr ted the M36 to personnel of C Comd "B", 3rd Armd Div. Co CP w/2nd Plt moved to (K923382) vic DORFF. "C" Co fired 58 rds 3" HE on indirect missions. Four (4) M36's went into indirect firing position at (A923374) vic BREINIG.

4 Oct 44.- "A" Co moved four (4) M36's into indirect firin, position at (4907383) vio KORNELIMUNSTER.

Attempts to regist r 90mm plat of "G" Go were unsuccess-

ful. Both air and ground Or's were exployed.

Harassing fires were prepared by both 90mm plts for the night, but were not fired.

Platoon of 3" guns fired 250 rds HB during the puriod on herassing missions.

5 Out 44.- Fired total of 95 rds 3" Hound 83 rds 90am HB on 15 r ssin missions during the period.

6 Oct 44.- Four (4) M36's from Co "3" went into indirect firmaposition at (x938386) vio BRMIGIG.

No missions were fired during the period.

7 Opt 44.- Personnel of the battarion voted this date, if they so desired.

12 Oct 44.- "3" Co moved their 90 mm lit to K92503970 via ERTRIG. Observed missions more fire throughout the day on thrusts of opportunity, including suspected for locations, enough buttery locations and transport. Heroscing fired word prepared for the night. Not a sum oxyended: 164 rds 90 mm and 108 rds 3" HE.

15 Dot 44. - Medium enemy artitlery fell in the MM GP area and in 60 %0° area from period 6615 to 0645 hours. Casualties were eme (1) BM ETA, sum (1) MM ETA.

Amos expended for the period was 192 rds 50mm HB and 188 rds 5° EE.

17.0et 44.- Received fourteen (14) additional M36's this date. These were broken down as follows: six (5) each to "A" and "3" Co's, two (2) to "O" Co. Total destroyers in Ma: 32 M36 end 4 M10. Orders were received at 1200 hours to have one (1) Fit of destroyers alerted to move to the First Inf Div sens of action. The plt under command of Lt BUGGAMER, moved out at 1550 hours and assembled in sector of 1st Bn, 26th Inf Begt at 1700 hours. Location, (M888442) vio BILENDORF. Mission to support infentry defensive sector. 620 rds 90mm RE and 342 rds 3" RE fired during the period on harassing missions. Co "C" moved to (M922381) vie BREINIGERHEIDE.

18 Oot 44.- At 1100 hours Co "A" moved one (1) plt into indirect firing position at (£907383). The En ration truck was hit by enemy artitlery fire in vic of BREINIG at 1700 hours. The ration sergeant was wounded and evacuated. Anno expended for the period was 582 rds 90mm HE and 543 rds 3" HE.

19 Oot 44. - Enemy counterbattery fire fell on the "A" Co plat, shortly after midnight. Casualties one (1) Em KIA, one (1) Em wounded. Fire was resused with a repitition of counterbattery fire, so the mission was called off. This plt moved to new position at (K913359) vio HAHN at 1350 hours. 3rd Plt of Co "C" moved to initializate (K909377) to continue indirect fire missions. One section of 90mm guns replaced 3" guns on road elock, vio HAUSBAON.

20 Oct 44.- Fired 1,106 rds of 3" HE during the period 201800 to 200800 on harassing missions in vio of ESCHTTIMER. Received the final four (4) M36 s this date, thus bringing the total to the 36 authorized.

One (1) M-8 from Ron Co was destroyed by enemy shell fire during the night an vic of (1950418). No personnel ossualties.

22 Oct 44 .- Section of "d" do on road slock vio-of MAUGRACH was releived at 1500 hours, andreturned to company control. During the period expended 500 res 90x HE on harassing missions.

23 Oct 44.- "A" Co abved to (A931405) vic BUSRACH. Aman expended during the period was 1,742 rds 90mm HE.
