

D. LOEWENTHAL PROMOTED TO ARMY CAPTAIN

WITH THE FIFTH ARMY, Italy, Feb. 23—Daniel Loewenthal, son of Leo B. Loewenthal of Saranac Lake, N. Y., recently was promoted from first lieutenant to captain while serving on the Fifth Army front in Italy.

He is now adjutant, special service officer and post exchange officer in the 894th Tank Destroyer Battalion. Formerly he was a platoon leader, liaison officer and personnel officer.

Capt. Loewenthal attended Rutgers university, New Jersey, being graduated there in June, 1938. In civilian life he was a soil surveyor before entering active service in January, 1942.
