
AWARD OF THE BRONZE STAR MEDAL

By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to:

ADOLPH A. HASCHKE

38 011 993, Private First Class, Field Artillery, Company B, 692nd Tank Destroyer Battalion for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States from 28 October 1944 to 7 May 1945 in Holland, France and Germany.

As driver of a quarter-ton truck, Private Haschke displayed courage and initiative during many trips under enemy fire from the company command post to the most forward elements of his organization. Private Haschke frequently volunteered to make trips through artillery and small arms fire and over roads not swept of mines to carry important messages. On one such trip his vehicle was destroyed by artillery fire, but Private Haschke, proceeded on foot and delivered the instructions he was carrying. His devotion to duty contributed effectively to the success of his unit in combat. Entered military service from Cedar Rapids, Nebraska.
