- As of 221200B Apr 45, VIII U.S. Corps (76th Inf Div, 87th Inf Div, 89th Inf Div, 6th Armd Div and 6th Cav Gp) passed to Conti of FIRST U.S.Army.
- II. Contact with Soviet Forces.
 - No member of this Comd will give information to the "Press" regarding contact with Soviet Forces. Comdrs will insure that this is complied with.
 - To avoid confusion and prevent expansion to areas to be occupied by Soviet Forces, Trs of the 87th Inf Div will not Adv beyond the present Limiting Line nor Ptyl beyond the present Ptrl line.
 - Ptrls sent Fr the current front lines to the E or front will be led by an officer and will include an interpreter. If Soviet Forces are contacted the officer leading the Ptrl will:
 - Attempt to contact the nearest Soviet Officer.
 - Extend a cordial greating to the Soviet Officer
 - Invite the Soviet Officer to visit the immediate superior of the officer leading the Ptrl. This is in no way intended to relax previous restrictions on patrolling to the E.
 - It is to be expected that Soviet Forces will contact Elms of the Div at an early date. When such contact is made, our Trs will remain in present Pos's, except that Ptrls will not operate beyond the present Limiting Line.
 - When contact is made with Soviet Forces, the senior American Officer on the spot will contact the appropriate senior Soviet Comdr, offer cordial greetings, explain our situation on the immediate front, and obtain the situation and plans of the Soviet Comdr. The result of such conference will be Rptd so as to reach the Div Comdr W/out delay.
 - In all cases, Rpt of first contact of Soviet Forces will be Rptd to Div $\mathrm{Hq}_{\,\bullet}$
 - It is assumed that Soviet Forces, other than In Parties, will not enter the area occupied by our Trs. If, however, these forces desire to enter the area in large numbers, the Comdr of our Trs will request that such be not done until a conference with the Dam Gendr.
 - Trs will be impressed with the necessity for caution in order that Soviet Tracro now find per when contact is being made. After contact is made, the disposition of forces should be known to both sides, an order that proper contact and proper relations may be observed.

- 9. Every effort will be made to avoid any accidental clashes with Soviet Forces,
- 10. During period of link-up between forces under SHAEF and Soviet High Comd the following overall recognition

signal will apply:
a. (1) AEF Elms will identify themselves by a series of more than two (2) green Very lights or

green star rockets.

(2) Soviet Forces will employ series of red rockets.

Armd Vahicle Markings:
(1) AEF Armd and other vehicles will Cont to carry normal markings. Soviets have been informed that yellow and/or cerise flourescent panels may be seen from the air depending upon local orders of the day.

Soviet Armd vehicles will carry a white band painted completely around the turrent in the center thereof and a white cross on top of the turret.

Aircraft will carry nationally prescribed markings,

ll. Dissemination of Rpts of incidents, or of rumors which may lead to unfortunate incidents, is prohibited,

MESSAGE FROM HALF-YEAR 6 (CG 87TH INF DIV) Received 1045, 7 May 45.

It is anticipated that large numbers of German troops may be coming toward our lines to surrender. The surrender of individual and units will be accepted. Personnel will be disarmed, arms stacked, and vehicles assembled in motor parks. In so far as practicable members of same unit will be kept together. Both individual and unit will be processed thru PW channels. Captured weapons and vehicles will be assembled and kept under guard by capturing organization pending insturctions as to their dispostion.

There will be no - \underline{no} - demonstration of any kind in connection with the surrender.



MESSAGE FROM MONARCH (VIIICORPS)

- 1. Representatives of the German High Command have signed an unconditional surrender of all German land, sea and air forces to the AEF and simultaneously to the Soviet High Command at OlllB, 7 May 45, under which all forces will cease active operation at OOOlB, 9 May 45.
- 2. Effective immediately all offensive operations will cease. Troops will remain in present positions. Moves involved in occupation duty will continue. Due to the difficulty in communication there may be some delay in orders reaching enemy troops, so full defensive precautions will be taken. No release to the press pending official announcement to the press by the heads of the three major powers.
