7. Battles.

The greater part of the menth was spent in reorganizing personnel and vehicles of the battalien and drawing the new M-36 (90mm) destroyers. On 21st of October a test fire was conducted against an eld fort just merth of TOUL. Results are tabulated in appended report.

The Battalien came under centrel of 9th Tank Destroyer Group on the 24th October. On the 28th of October the Battalien was given the mission of supporting the fires of the 775th F. A. Battalien, with one (1) Tank Destroyer plateen in the vicinity of RELLEAU and the fires of the 738th F.A. Battalien with two T.D. plateens in the vicinity of MAZERULES. Plateens of the Battalien retated on the above missions for the remainder of the menth.
