To be activated less pioneer company and one destroyer company, As a guide, reduced strength may be apportioned within the battalion as follows: Hq & Hq Co (T/O 18-16) 6 Off, 36 EM; Cos A & B (T/O 18-17) ea: 5 Off, 102 EM. AT elements of 148th FA (less 1st Battalion) and of the 218th FA (less 2d Battalion) will not be inactivated or transferred at this time.

x. The reduced strength makes available a battalion (less pioneer company and one destroyer company) with a Hq Co at reduced strength and with destroyer companies less security sections. For training purposes an engineer company and an infantry rifle company may be attached to the battalion to substitute for missing elements.
