HEADODALLERS SAATH TANK MESTROWN MATTALION

-Bacard of Operations -1-9 May 1945

At the beginning of the period the battalion (less supery A and the Boar CP) were in an assumbly area in the vicinity of GCDDINGER, GERHARY. Company A was across the ELE River, supporting the 504th Parachute Regiment of the All Aisborne Division. The Battalion Rear CP was located AT KINCHMETER. GERMANY.

At 010600 May one (1) destroyer from the 30 lateon. Someony A. struck a large mine which everturned and burned the destroyer.

During the day the lat and 3d Platoons of Reconnaiscance Company continued to support the 504th Parachute Infantry Regiment and spent the day enlarging the bridgehead over the ELE Piver.

At 1000 hours on 1 Hay the Battalion was detached from the 434 Airborne Division and was attached to the 8th infantry

Friar to darkness on the 1st of May the Battalion had all elements across the FLRE River and had assembled in the bridgehead area in the vicinity of BAHLEN, GERMANY.

Starting at 0600 hours on 2 May the entire Battalion (-Boar GP) engaged in attacking North from BAHLEN, GLENANY, the unit was in two (2) columns: Companies B and C, the Forward CP, Recennaissance Company (-one platoon), were with Task Force ADAMS, along with elements of the 740th Touch Battalien, the 121st Infantry Regiment, and other waits; * Company A and one plateon of Reconnectsence Company were with Task Force KUNZIG, which also included elements of the 121st Infantry Regiment and other units. An advance of from 35 to 40 miles was made to coordinates (348689), west of SCHWERIN, GERMANY. There was no incident. Cal .50 firing and some small arms were the only weapons asad. Two (2) German planes were sighted during the advance. Company A destroyed one (1) enemy lisison plane. Numerous prisoners of war were taken by all participating units. Sovement toward the Baltic Sea was halted by wivision order and at the end of the day the battalion was in the following locations:

on 3 May the Battalion remained in an assembly and carried on maintenance of materiel, repair and reorganisation, in addition to rounding up numerous prisoners of war in had around all unit areas. During the latter part of the day the Rear CP moved into SCHWARIN and the balance of the businessembled in Gross ROGALN and Kleiner ROGALN.

At 1800 hours Reconnaissance Company was given the mission of driving and guarding prisoners of war. One platoon began this mission at the end of the day.

During the remainder of the period the entire Battalion assembled in SCHWERIN, GERMANY, All companies were given missions of guarding prisoners of war and administering displaced persons' camps. The period ended with the entire unit engaging in these missions.
