INACTIVATION OF UNITS

1. PAC, Ltr, ASF, NYPE, Brooklyn, NY, file SPTAA 322 GM (CAD) (45-5568), dtd 23 October 1945, Subject: Inactivation of Certain Units, the fol units are inactivated eff 2359 hours 27 Oct '45 and transferred in an inactive status to the control of the War Department:-

24th Chemical Decontamination Company Company C, 679th Tank Destroyer Battalion (Towed)

- 2. a. Personnel will be transferred by this headquarters to appropriate Reception Stations, as prescribed in RRL-6 for disposition.
- b. No personnel will be reduced in grade as result of this action. Excess in grades resulting therefrom will be absorbed through normal attrition and the application of the provisions of AR 615-5, 30 June 1943, as amended.
- 3. Equipment will be turned into Area Commander as prescribed in Section VII, RRI-6 and by Area Commanding Officer.
- 4. Personnel Records will be prepared and processed under the supervision of Area Commanding Officer in accordance with provisions of paragraph Ile, RRI-6.
- 5. Unit funds and physical property thereof will be disposed of as prescribed in Section IV, RRL-6, and by Chief, Fiscal Branch, this headquarters.
- 6. Records of the inactivated units will be disposed of and reported to this headquarters by Area Commanding Officer in accordance with AR 15-15, dtd 20 Sept 145 and as prescribed in Section VIII, RR1-6.
