Co B fired 18 rds SMK to register. At 1400 hrs for purposes of registration Co B fired 54 rds H.E. No missions fired during the day. But between 2230 24 Sept 44 and 0548 hrs 25 Sept Co B fired 51 Missions of concentration fire using 728 rds H.E. (Inc. Fire) At 0415 hrs 25 Sept 44 175th F.A.Gp. Comdr expressed his pleasure and the pleasure of Corps Arty Comr and 1st Army Comdr over the effectiveness of our Co B fires of the nights of 23rd-24th-25th Sept. 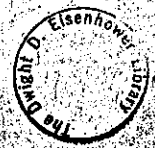

4. OPERATIONS FOR PERIOD: (Brief Summary) Total: 585. At 1300 hrs, 2nd & 3rd pls of Co A left LUNEVILLE. At 1400 hrs, Co CP and 1st pl moved to EINVILLE. At 1745, 3rd pl fired 15 rds NE at BAUZACONT. At 1830 hrs, pl moved to (124079) firing 26 rds NE, 3 rds APC at NEZAMENIL. At 1745 hrs, 1st pl received fairly hvy enemy arty and mortar fire - no casualties. Total rds fired 28 Sept: 125 rds NE, 3 rds APC.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS TO IMPROVE COMBAT EFFICIENCY:4. OPERATIONS FOR PERIOD (Cont'd):

29 Sept: Co A, atchd to 106 Cav Bn, destroyed four (4) M4 IV Tanks, two M4 V Tanks, one Half-Track, and two LVT trucks between the hours of 1530 and 1630. All except two vehicles were fired on until burned, in areas 1 & 2 (see overlay). Enemy btry, believed to be SF Guns, neutralized at Pt. 6. At Pt. 7, at 1830 hrs, enemy vehicles were brought under indirect fire after which no motors were heard. Co A also planned interdictory fire during night at Pts 8, 9. Estimated enemy infantry killed by Co A - approx 80.

28 Sept:- Between 0900-1030 hrs, Co B fired 486 rds HE (indir), 42 miss. Between 1030 hrs 28 Sept and 0615 hrs, 29 Sept, Co B fired 55 missions conc fire expending 609 rds HE making a total of 97 missions and 1095 rds expended. Later in the afternoon of 28 Sept, Co B fired approx 300 more rds HE making a total of about 1395 rds HE exp between 0900 hrs, 28 Sept and 1800 hrs, 29 Sept. For the period, however, of this report, approx 900 rds HE - 76 BM K were exp between 1600 hrs 28 Sept and 1800 hrs 29 Sept by Co B (and 60 missions).

28 Sept:- Co C's pls moved to 2200 yds W of BAUZMONT; 2nd & 3rd pls firing 180 rds HE on enemy in BAUZMONT w/1st pl in support. At 1630 hrs, 28 Sept, friendly tanks entered the town. 74 PNs were taken by 121 Cav. 1st pl moved from fwd pos to vic VALNAY. 2nd & 3rd pls in defensive pos high ground overlooking BAUZMONT. Co CP at SARRAS (06310); total rds HE exp; 180 rds.

29 Sept:- Co C, atchd to 121 Cav Bn, destroyed eight (8) M4 IV Tanks in areas 3 & 4, and one (1) Half-Track. All above v hicles fired upon until burned. Also fired HE into estimated 200 enemy infantry; estimated 10% of enemy killed. Neutralized enemy OP at Pt. 5.

29 Sept:- Recon Co, reinforced by one M-10, destroyed one (1) M4 IV Tank in area 4 (see overlay).

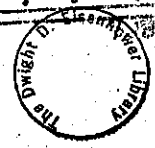

Co B, from ind fire pos in LUNEVILLE, fired 63 missions conc fire exp 624 rds HE. Today an arty observer reported to Co B PIC that he had observed Co B's fire on a cross road and road 1/2 mile long. He reported numerous Ger-  
mans killed and enemy equipment (did not specify) knocked out; saw three 1/2  
truckloads of dead Germans evacuated and estimated that it would take at  
least five more trucks to evacuate remainder of dead Germans. Col Moore,  
162 FA Bn, verified that Co B was only unit to fire into that sector. 12  
more missions were fired during night; results will appear on TD report 26.  
Lack of HE prevented firing additional missions; only 52 rds fired at 1800-  
1900 hrs. Total for day: 684 rds HE.

NOTE: At 1600 hrs, American Signal Corp took pictures of 2nd pl in action. About the same time, a sub plane observer spotted an enemy btry and adjusted 2nd pl on target. 2nd pl fired 3 volleys on target and observer reported that rounds were on target and that the enemy btry was either silenced or destroyed.
