815th T. D. 1 pl Co C atchd 106 Cav Gp during the week. The Cos of this Bn underwent a fairly hectic week. However, for the most part, the Bn considers it came out on top for the week's operations. For the week, this Bn added to its accomplishments a very satisfactory comm and liaison setup of which it feels pretty proud. Along with its accomplishments as is to be expected, this Bn wa sunfortunate in losing five (5) M-10s by enemy action. We also had five (5) of our boys kille d and a few casualties, but we feel that our destruction of Germans more than offset these fatalities. The boys of the Bn in the gun Cos underwent a great deal of shell fire during the week, but on the whole showed no ill effects and held up real well. These boys were called upon to make several

night moves and moves in very difficult terrain; in both instances, the boys came through with flying colors, proving th eveselves real TDs and complete masters of their destroyers.
