BRIEF SULWARY OF BATTALION OPERATIONS DURING FERIOD OF THIS REPORT.

813th T.D.BATTALION: (Atchd 7 th Inf. Div.

- 1. a. At 1530 hrs, I Sept, Bn moved from vic of MACHY EN VEXIN to vic of TESCAMPS; distance traveled: 70.3 mi.
- b. At 0815 hrs, 2 Sept, Bn crossed SOMME RIVER and proceeded to ORTHICS-RUMEGIES (coord 808197) closing at 0150 hrs, 3 Sept; distance traveled: 75.5 mi.
- 2. From S Sept to 7 Sept, Bn in biv near ORTHIES-RUMEUIES near Belgian border. At 0500 hrs, 7 Sept 44, the 815th TD Bn (minus Co. "C" which had previously left with CT 5 in a upport of 315th Inf Regt) moved from vic of ORTHIES-RUMEUIES near the forder to a point 7 mi) S of REIMS; distance traveled: 161 mi, closing at 2200 hrs. Weather rainy, roads good. Many vehicles straggling on this march due to worn tracks making operation of vehicles a danger-ous undertaking.
- 3. At 1000 hrs, 8 Sept 44, 813th TD Bn (-) less Co. "C", left biv area 7 mi 5 of REIMS, proceeding by motor convoy and closing at 2140 hrs in vic of MATHONS (coord 007836); dis tance traveled: 126 mi; weather generally rainy, roads good. Co. "C" had left earlier with CT 5 in support of 315th Inf Regt at 0100 hrs and went into biv area at approximately (coord 137647) across the MARKE RIVER. BARRADOMNY (Atticles straggling on) his merch; badly worn tracks increasing the possibility of danger and accident.
- 4. Co. "C" relieved by the 77%rd TD Bn and returned to Bn biv area vic of MATHONS at 2000 hrs, 10 Sept 44.
 - 5. In engaged in general maintenance of all vecicles and arms.
