
During the month of February 1945 the 825th TD Battalion (less detached units) continued to provide the perimeter defense of Headquarters, Twelfth Army Group TAC at Namur, Belgium.

Company "A" attached to "T" Force spent the month in a rest area near Solieres, Belgium. On 1 February 1945 the third squad of the First Platoon, Company "B" moved as security for a VHF installation to the vicinity of Lesres, Belgium and Company "C", having completed its mission with Task Force "REED" in the vicinity of Sandweiler, Luxembourg, joined the remainder of the battalion at Namur.

On 11 February, Company "B" was relieved of its mission of securing VHF stations all along the front and was assembled at Namur bringing in men who had been on extended field service since mid-October 1944. Company "C" immediately replaced Company "B" in this assignment.

Thirty-seven (37) men were placed on temporary duty 20 - 21 February with the 814th TD Battalion near Verviers, Belgium for a period of instruction and orientation in the operation of the TD Battalion, Self-propelled, M-36.
