In compliance with Section I, Administrative Bulletin Number 71, Headquarters, Sp Trs, 12th ACP, dated 24 October 1944, the following report is submitted:

**J U N E**

During the month of June, the 825th TD Battalion (Less Detached Units) were relieved of providing perimeter defense of Headquarters, 12th Army Group TAG.

**BATTALION**

On 15 June 1945 a parade and review was held by this organization at which time Pfc Albert L. Turgeon, Company "A" and Pvt George W. Webber, Medical Detachment were awarded the Purple Heart.

On 29 June 1945 a parade and review was held by this organization at which time Capt. Walter L. Connell, Jr. and Pfc Henry L. Brooks, Company "B" were awarded the Bronze Star Medal and Pvt Beecher Millsaps, Company "A" was awarded the Purple Heart.

**HEADQUARTERS COMPANY**

First Reconnaissance Platoon continued to provide security for VHF Radio Installations.

Second Reconnaissance Platoon continued to provide escort guard for Commanding General, 12th Army Group.

On 2 June 1945 Headquarters and Headquarters Company moved from Bad-Wildungen, Germany to Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany.

**COMPANY "A"**

On 6 June 1945 Company "A" furnished two (2) man guard detail posted at Press Camp in Schierstein, Germany.

On 19 June 1945 Company "A" furnished one (1) man, 24-hour guard post established at billets of Transportation Corps' Officers at 5, 7, and 11 Richard Wagner Strasse, Biebrich, Germany.

**COMPANY "B"**

On 1 June 1945, 4th Squad, 3rd Platoon Company "B" departed vicinity of Erlangen, Germany for vicinity East of Frankfurt, Germany.

On 1 June 1945, 1st Squad, 3rd Platoon Company "B" moved from vicinity of Bad-Wildungen, Germany to vicinity of Arnsfeld, Germany.

On 1 June 1945, 3rd Squad, 2nd Platoon, Company "B" moved from vicinity of Bad-Wildungen, Germany to provide security for airstrip vicinity Wiesbaden, Germany.

On 2 June 1945, Company "B" less detached units moved from Bad-Wildungen, Germany to Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany.

On 5 June 1945, 4th Squad, 2nd Platoon Company "B" moved from vicinity of Bad Tols, Germany to vicinity of Augsburg, Germany.

On 7 June 1945, 1st Squad, 2nd Platoon departed vicinity Schierstein, Germany to provide security for radio station vicinity Sennenberg, Germany.

On 10 June 1945, 2nd Squad, 3rd Platoon Company "B" moved from vicinity of Zella-Mehlis, Germany to Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany.

**COMPANY "C"**

On 1 June 1945, 1st Squad, 1st Platoon, Company "C" moved from vicinity of Russelsheim, Germany to vicinity of Valdorf, Germany.

On 1 June 1945, 3rd Squad, 2nd Platoon moved from vicinity Hehenhard, Germany for vicinity Detmold, Germany.

On 1 June 1945, 3rd and 4th Squad, 1st Platoon relieved of security guard at HF Site vicinity Bad-Wildungen, Germany. Squads departed for Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany.

On 1 June 1945, 1st Squad, 2nd Platoon moved from vicinity of Regensburg, Germany to vicinity east of Bad Tols, Germany.

On 2 June 1945, Company "C" less detached units moved from Bad-Wildungen, Germany to Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany.

On 5 June 1945, 1st Squad, 2nd Platoon moved from vicinity east of Bad Tols, Germany to Garmisch, Germany.

On 7 June 1945, 3rd and 4th Squads, 1st Platoon moved from Kaserne Freudenberg, vicinity Schierstein, Germany to Hill 611 vicinity Northwest of Wiesbaden, Germany to provide security for HF Site.

On 16 June 1945, 2nd Squad, 1st Platoon departed vicinity Weimar, Germany for Schierstein, Germany. Squad relieved of guard duty for BBC Station.
