HISTORY OF THE 827TH TANK DESTROYER BATTALION FOR 1 9 4 3

1. Original Unit

Designation: 827th Tank Destroyer Battalion.

Date of organization: 20 April, 1942.

Place of organization: Camp Forrest, Tennesee.
Authority for organization: (a) Ltr, Hq AGF, 15 March,
Subject: Activation of Certain TD Units. (b) GO #17, Hq Camp Forrest, Tenn., 20 April, 1942.

Sources from which personnel was obtained: Cadre from 4th Cavalry Brigade, of 2d Cavalry Division, filler replacements received from various reception centers (4th SC) and from IRTC's at Camp Croft, S.C. and Camp Wolters, Texas.

2. Changes in organization: On 10 June, 1943, the Battalion was reorganized per Letter, Headquarters Army Ground Forces, 4 June, 1943, Subject: "Reorganization of Tank Destroyer Battalions", reference 521/14 (TD Units) (R) GNGCT (6-4-43) as a towed battalion under T/O 18935, 7 May, 1943. This Change caused the inactivation of Reconnaissance Company. On 20 July, 1943, the Battalion was reorganized per Letter, Headquarters, Army Ground Forces, 13 July, 1943, Subject: "Reorganization of 662d and 827th Tank Destroyer Battalions", reference 321/18 (TD Units) (R) 13 July, 1943) GNGCT as a self-propelled battalion under T/O 18-25, dated 27 January, 1943. Reserved for the second s connaissance Company was reactivated.
