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UNIT HISTORY

Throughout the month of June 1945 and until 22 July, the battalion continued to function without change in its earlier assignments. Until 22 July it remained attached to Headquarters, Special Troops, 6th Army Group, for administration and supply. The assignment for operations to AC of S G-2 Section, 6th Army Group, was continued.

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During this period the essential operation of the unit was the effective conduction of acamp, billeting and transporting members of 6th Army Group T-Section.

On 12 June 1945, Company "A" with attached personnel returned from Munich to Heidelberg with 6th Army Group TeForce Specialists pcamp per verbal orders Commanding Officer, T-Borce Camp. On 9 July Company "A" was relieved of duties in connection with said camp and joined Battalion at Leimen, Germany. On 15 July, Major Carl A Fraser assumed command of battalion.

On 22 July, battalion moved by motor from Leimen, Germany to Nancy France, preceded by Companies "A" and "C" which moved by rail 21 July. Movement was performed pursuant to letter orders, Headquarters, Special Troops, 6th Army Group, File No. 370, Subject: Movement Orders, dated 16 July 1945. Upon departure, pursuant to said orders, battalion was relieved from attachment to Special Troops, 6th Army Group.

On 23 July, battalion moved from Nancy, France to Dijon, France. On 24 July, battalion moved from Dijon, France to St. Ramberts, France. On 25 July, battalion moed from St. Ramberts, France to Arles, France, thereby completing movement referred to in above mentioned order, and coming under operational control of Delta Base Section, Marseilles, France.

Battalion was constituted Category IV unit and during period from 25 July to 25 August, personnel was withdrawn for assignment to Category II units. On 29 August, battalion moved from Arles, France to Marseilles, France per VOCG, Delta Base Section, of 29 August.

On 21 October, battalion moved from Marseilles, France to Calas Staging Area, France to receive personnel eligible for discharge prior to movement to the United States for demobilization under Movement Order RE 7415, Headquarters, United States Forces, European Theater. Movement to Calas from Marseilles was performed pursuant to VOCG, Delta Base Section of 20 October 1945. Battalion engaged in accomplishment of mission throughout balance of October, 1945.
